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WHAT WE SET OUT TO DO

- Training that
 - Combines legal aspects of issuing and receiving and EIO with business aspects of eEDES
 - Can be used with experts as well as novice persons to EIOs
 - Can be used in in-person trainings – physical, using video conferencing, hybrid

THE TREIO IN-PERSON TRAINING

- Used with experts as well as novice persons to EIOs
- Used in in-person trainings – physical, using video conferencing, hybrid

- 2 training modules separated with sufficient time for exploring eEDES
- Taking place online
- Led by Master Trainers
- Conducted in national language
- Close to launching eEDES

WE HAVE TESTED THIS METHOD

- In-person training
 - In national language
 - National trainers
- Online training sessions
 - In English by TREIO training team
- Hybrid training
 - In national language
 - By TREIO and/or national trainers
- TREIO training for national trainers
- TREIO trainers together with national trainers
- National trainers supported by TREIO

THE TREIO IN-PERSON TRAINING

- Speaks to several audiences (judges, prosecutors, administrative colleagues, law enforcement (where they are involved in an EIO process))

TRAINING AUDIENCE

Training content targets

- judges
- prosecutors
- members of other competent authorities (identified in Article 2 EIO Directive)
- higher administrative officials employed at a judicial authority and who may be responsible of assisting judges and prosecutors

responsible for the issuing and/or executing of an EIO



THE TREIO IN-PERSON TRAINING

- Can be executed by different trainers
- Can be adapted to national needs
- Is translated to several languages of the EU

LANGUAGES

- Master version in English
- Already translated in 16 languages:
 - BG, CZ, DE, EL, ES, FI, FR, HR, IT, LT, PT, RO, SL, NL, SE, SK
- Translation by professional translations and most have been validated by practitioners

TREIO CASCADING TRAIN-THE-TRAINER METHODOLOGY

- Training for Master Trainers
- National training for trainers for piloting Member States
 - Dedicated to the EIO implementation and the use of eEDES
 - Held separately across the Member States in line with the needs of the national authorities
 - Led by national Master Trainers, appointed by competent authorities and trained/supported by TREIO Team
- International webinars
 - Focus on the cross-border aspects
 - Bringing together participants involved in the national trainings from several Member States
 - Led by TREIO Team
 - Recording available after sessions.
- Follow-up validation sessions collecting feedback from Master Trainers and participants alike

FLEXIBILITY IN TRAINING MODALITIES

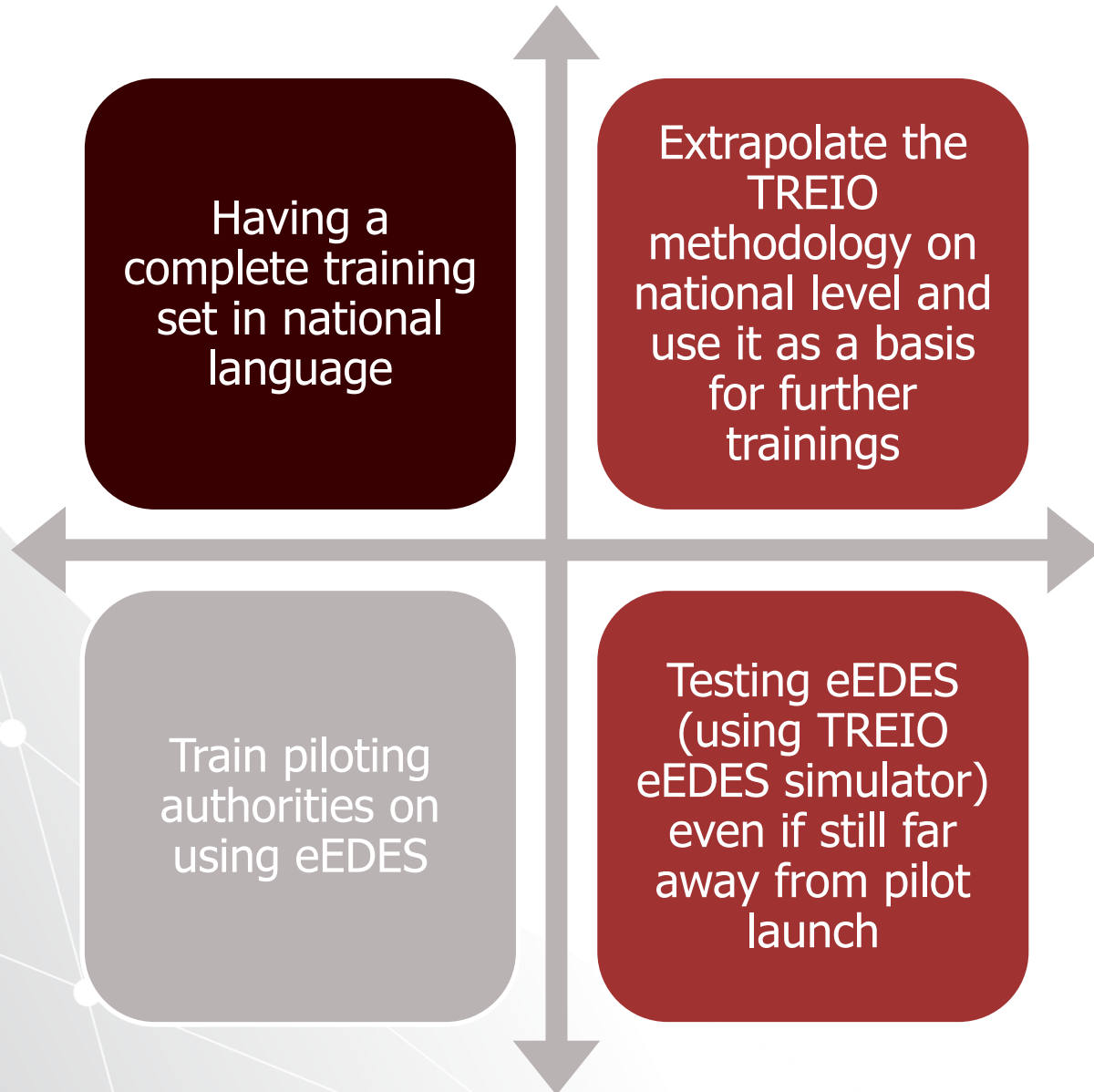
From experience, we see that the training modules can be used to fit:

- A training tailored to national specifics
 - Allows focusing on different roles in the national workflow
- Training of participants with previous EIO experience
 - Focusing only/primarily on use of eEDES
- Training of participants with little or no EIO experience
 - Using complete training set of modules and content

FLEXIBILITY IN TRAINING MODALITIES

From experience, we see that the training modules can be used to fit:

- Both online / on site organization
- Focused training on EIO only or as part of training on Judicial Cooperation
- Varying time schedule
 - 2-day onsite training extended with discussions on national practices
 - 1-day onsite training following the TREIO curriculum with extra time for practicing the use of eEDES
 - 2 half-day modules held online following the TREIO curriculum
 - 1 half-day (or split into 2 shorter modules) online training with specific focus on using e-EDES
